T-MOBILE PHONE TO ANOTHER WIRELESS PHONE

- 1. Select "Write Message" or similar option from your messaging menu.
- Write your message using the keypad on your phone.
- Send the message to the recipient's 11-digit phone number (1+ area code + 7 digit wireless number).

"Hi Bob." (Send to) "1+xxx+xxxxxxx"

No long distance charges will be incurred when making local calls within your calling area.

T-MOBILE PHONE TO AN E-MAIL ADDRESS

- Select "Write Message" or similar option from your messaging menu.
- Enter recipient's e-mail address followed by a single space.
- 3. Write your message.
- 4. Send it to "500."

Joe@abc.com (space) "Hi Bob." (Send to) "500"

PC E-MAIL TO T-MOBILE PHONE

Every T-Mobile phone comes with an e-mail address. It is your 10-digit phone number (area code + your number) @ tmomail.net

- Write message on PC.
- 2. Send to 10-digit phone number @ tmomail.net

START MESSAGING IMMEDIATELY

Your phone is already set up and ready to go!

When a message arrives, your phone will ask if you want to read it. Just follow the prompts for reading, saving and deleting the message. To reply, just click "Reply," write your message and send it. The phone automatically takes care of the addressing.

MESSAGE DELIVERY

T-Mobile attempts to send messages to you for up to 72 hours. If your phone isn't on or within the service area during the 72-hour time frame, the messages will be deleted or lost.

After you send your message, wait for the "Message Sent" confirmation to ensure your message is on its way.
